In this graduate course you will develop knowledge and skills for program design, implementation planning and evaluation applicable to a range of practice areas. Through the readings and use of internet resources, students will engage in structured reflection and discussion on the theoretical and practical issues in the field of program evaluation with a particular eye to considerations for occupational therapy practice. Independent reading will be accompanied by a series of assignments that take the student through the various stages and types of evaluation and end with the development of a major project related to the course content.

If you are someone who wants to learn about how to plan more effective programs, or wonders how to evaluate new or existing programs so that you are capturing the information you need, then this course may be for you! You'll develop your own program design and evaluation plan focused on a self-selected program.
